

Artistic vineyard escape

Since our last visit, an extensive cypress hedge has been taken down on this property, opening up expansive views across neighbouring vineyards to Mount Riddell and the Yarra Valley hills beyond. Adding to this setting is the outlook from the two elevated accommodation suites – from one you can see Ernst Fries' beautiful stainless steel and glass sculptures set before the property's own small vineyard.

Artwork in its many forms is a real feature here. From sculptures and paintings to drawings and three-dimensional stained glass creations, the ever-changing exhibitions of various artists in the on-site gallery are food for the imagination.

As an added bonus, each of the mud brick and timber suites also features artwork from the gallery.

The suites are warm and inviting. There's something about the golden mud brick that invites cosy relaxation in front of the wood fire in the cooler months or on the terrace on a warm day.

The generous breakfast provisions make for the perfect start to a day of Yarra Valley cellar-door hopping and discovering the region's top restaurants, cafes and farm gates.
